



BPBA Social Mixed Competition



Rules:

The official Australian Basketball rules will apply with the following additions/amendments

Key restrictions:

- Eastern Key - (canteen/foyer end of court) – Males are prohibited from entering this area.
- Western Key - Females are prohibited from entering this area.
- Both males and females can shoot from outside the key.

Gender restrictions:

- No more than 3 players of one gender.
- Each team must have a minimum of 2 female players on the court at all times.
- Game can only start with 4 players.

Scoring restrictions:

- Players can score a maximum of 10points per game.
- Once all active players from a team have scored 10pts the restrictions reset, and players may score an additional 10points each.

Timing rules:

- 2 x 20min halves
- 1 timeout per team per half
- 2min half time
- Clock stops in last 1min of 2nd half (if margin is less then 10pts).
- Running clock

Finals Qualification:

- Players must qualify as per BPBA By-Laws to participate in finals.
- Byes count as qualification games.

Other:

- Players must purchase a game ticket prior to game commencing.
- Each team **MUST** provide a scorer.
- First named team will shoot to the East end of the court (canteen/foyer end).

Referees:

- Referees of mixed basketball are encouraged to administer the game with an eye to the social aspect and firmly controlling the possible unruly behaviour and unsportsmanlike conduct that is possible.

Player behaviour:

- **The emphasis of this SOCIAL competition is on fun and fitness.**
- It is expected that all players recognise this, and conduct themselves in such way that is in keeping with this philosophy.
- Unruly and disrespectful behaviour will not be tolerated, and will result in further action by BPBA.
